

This painting is an homage to my hometown of Baltimore and the Chesapeake Bay. A traditional mid-Atlantic crab feast happens in the summer and early fall, and is best enjoyed with all the trimmings: Old Bay seasoning, corn on the cob, oysters, and ice-cold beer. Picking crabs tends to get a bit messy, so covering the table with the local newspaper aids in a speedy clean-up.

Many watercolorists work from light to dark, saving the blacks for last. But the way I process color and value, I find it helpful to do the black background first. From there, I work from the back items to the front. I apply wet into wet washes to establish form, then glaze layers until a fairly complete finish is achieved before moving on to the next section. One of the things I enjoyed most about this painting was the opportunity to explore a variety of unique textures like galvanized metal and spiky crustaceans.
